

Notes on “Reformation Festival 2016”

- The service has been prepared in two formats: a small bulletin using 8.5”x11” paper and large bulletin using 8.5”x14” paper.
- The service was created using Word 2013 and will require some formatting adjustments when opened in other versions. For this reason, a PDF of the service is included in order to see the format as intended by the Worship Committee.
- Fonts used in the word documents include: Script MT Bold for the title on the cover page and Arial throughout the rest of the bulletin.
- Bookfold – each of the Word Documents is currently set to print in bookfold. This setting can be adjusted/removed by clicking on Page Layout>Margins>Custom Margins.
- The picture on the cover was taken by a member of the Worship Committee. There are no copyright issues concerning the reproduction of this photo.
- Each pastor will need to make the following edits before using the service:
 1. Congregation information and date/time of service on the cover page should be changed to match your local situation.
 2. The name of each pastor is to be inserted in each of the sermonette headings. In cases where the same pastor will give all three sermons, this information can simply be removed.
 3. If your group is not using the choir anthem “By Faith”, the information after the third sermonette must be changed to reflect the local selection.
 4. The closing hymn chosen by the Worship Committee (LSB 941 – We Praise You and Acknowledge You, O God) is a form of the Te Deum. Use of this hymn requires copyright reporting in order to be legally included in the bulletin. If your congregation subscribes to a copyright service such as OneLicense or LSB HymnLicense, you will need to change the notice below the hymn to reflect your congregation’s information.

If you do not have a legal way of reporting copyright usage, you must remove this hymn from the bulletin.

For congregations that do not currently report copyright usage, two public domain options of the Te Deum are suggested here.

Option 1: TLH 250

Option 2: Nahum Tate’s version of the Te Deum
(the suggested tune is Forest Green – LSB 362)

O God, we praise You, we confess that You alone are Lord
The everlasting Father, by the whole of earth adored.
To You all angels cry aloud, to You the powers on high,
Both cherubim and seraphim, continually do cry:

O holy, holy, holy Lord, whom heavenly hosts obey,
The world is with the glory filled of Your majestic ray.
Th' apostles' glorious company, and prophets crowned with light
With all the white robed martyrs' host, Your constant praise recite.

Your holy church throughout the world confesses You to be:
Eternal God and Father, of a boundless majesty;
Your honored true and only Son, so worthy of our praise;
The Spirit, our blest Comforter, who dwells in us always.
